

COMMUNITY PRAYER SESSIONS

ANNOINTING OF THE SICK

Anointing of the Sick can be administered to any Catholic who has reached the age of reason and is awaiting serious surgery, suffers from serious illness or is weakened by old age.

Kindly contact the Parish Office to request for a priest to administer the sacrament. In emergencies, either the priests of the parish or priests of the church nearest to the hospital can be contacted.

WEDDING

Kindly contact the Parish Office approximately 12 months before your intended date to book the church premises and ensure that your presiding priest is able to make the date. Do remind your priest 9 months prior to your wedding.

INFANT BAPTISM (Commencing in June)

Infant Baptisms will be held on the first Sunday of every month after our 11.00am Mass. Completed forms must be submitted to the parish office at least ONE month before the date of Baptism as parents and godparents will have to undergo two 2-hour sessions of preparation.

MASS OFFERING

Mass offering envelopes are available in the Parish Office. To ensure that Mass intentions are offered for the date and time specified, kindly submit your envelopes at least ONE week in advance of your intended date. Please write the names clearly in block letters.

Please note that for late submissions, intentions will be offered at the specified Mass but the intentions might not be screened.
