What is a retreat?

Many people think it is about a series of spiritual talks - that's a spiritual seminar. Retreats ultimately aim at **connecting our relationship with God** and naturally with those around us. It is like a couple spending time to connect with each other. Conversations in courtship bring about a bond and understanding towards each other, yet conversations alone will only distract the relationship. The most important essence is spending time together. Couples start out by spending time talking, but it is through time that talks become lesser, while appreciating each other's presence becomes more appreciated.

Retreats are helpful with talks to set direction, yet more importantly is the proportion of time included for prayers and reflection. Without that the retreat only becomes a spiritual event and not **a renewal of relationship with God**. As in a car that needs to fill petrol regularly, it will break down eventually if it is not sent for regular servicing and its performance will eventually deteriorate. While we may attend Masses regularly, without spending time on at least a retreat a year, our spirit in serving God will eventually be marred by our human tendencies and weaknesses.

Likewise, our relationships will be affected. Retreats are like servicing a car regularly, it goes beyond just topping up petrol. **The results of a retreat aim at renewing our relationship with God, reconciliation and finding freedom to let go of personal sins and habits, letting go of past hurts, reconciliation of relationships with one another, finding back one's personal joy and motivation in serving God and His people. And ultimately, becoming happier!**

ANNOINTING OF THE SICK

Anointing of the Sick can be administered to any Catholic who is awaiting serious surgery, suffers from serious illness or is weakened by old age.

Kindly contact the Parish Office to request for a priest to administer the sacrament. In emergencies, either the priests of the parish or priests of the church nearest to the hospital can be contacted.

WEDDING

Kindly contact the Parish Office approximately 12 months before your intended date to book the church premises and ensure that your presiding priest is able to make the date. Do remind your priest 9 months prior to your wedding.

INFANT BAPTISM

Infant Baptisms will be held on the first Sunday of every month after our 11.00 am Mass. Completed forms must be submitted to the parish office at least ONE month before the date of Baptism as parents and godparents will have to undergo two sessions of preparation.

MASS OFFERING

Mass offering envelopes are available in the Parish Office. To ensure that Mass intentions are offered for the date and time specified, kindly submit your envelopes at least ONE week in advance of your intended date. Please write the names clearly in block letters.

Please note that for late submissions, intentions will be offered at the specified Mass but the intentions might not be screened.

GENTLE REMINDER

We remind all parents of young children to refrain from bringing snacks, drinks, writing or colouring materials and toys to church to occupy your children during Mass. We seek your cooperation and understanding as we strive to cultivate a spirit of reverence in and around the main church. Thank you.
