Come as a parish community to spend an hour before the Blessed Sacrament. Bring your family and friends along.

The other day as I drove past a street, I noticed a young man sitting by the side of a building sobbing away. He looked homeless as he clung onto a blanket in the cold of the morning. Somehow that scene moved me beyond words, I just felt so sorry for him. The truth is that there are so many sufferings in the world. Likewise, you may be suffering and in your quiet moments may cry and sob away from the sight of others. You, too, have your sad story to tell. Then we ask, "Where is God?" Many a time in the Gospels, we see how Jesus chanced upon the people who were suffering and He was moved to compassion. Don't for a moment think that when anyone suffers or is in tears, God is not moved to compassion. Yet God will not necessarily remove every suffering that comes our way. Suffering is a mystery most of us do not understand, especially when we are in it. Yet for those who have no faith, nothing can take away the pain. But for those with faith, the suffering becomes an offering of love and privilege, no explanation is necessary. For such, they believe their suffering is never out of sight of God's compassion and presence.

BROADWAY ACTOR IS COMING TO COTT!



The Archdiocesan Biblical Apostolate is holding a series of bible talks on the Gospel of John.


