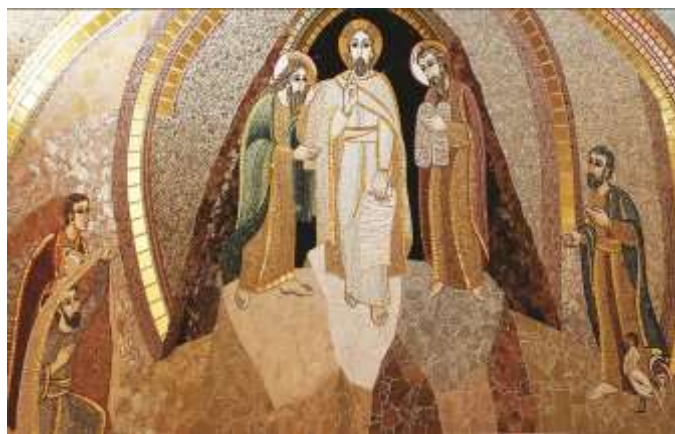

INFANT BAPTISM

Application forms (available at the Parish Office) must be completed and submitted with relevant documents attached. Parents and godparents will be informed of the date of the preparatory session that they would need to attend as well as the actual date of baptism.

BOOKINGS FOR WEDDINGS IN THE CATHOLIC CHURCH

Couples intending to enter into marriage in the Catholic Church will be required to book the date of the Church wedding one year in advance. The booking will be confirmed upon the couple signing the acknowledgement of the necessary requirements which the priest will explain to them.

ANNOINTING OF THE SICK

Anointing of the Sick can be administered to any Catholic who is awaiting serious surgery, suffers from serious illness or is weakened by old age. Kindly contact the Parish Office to request for a priest to administer the sacrament. In emergencies, either the priests of the parish or priests of the church nearest to the hospital can be contacted.

DONATIONS TO CHURCH OF THE TRANSFIGURATION
