MASS OFFERTORY CONTRIBUTION

The faithful who wish to make their weekly Mass offertory contribution to Church of the Transfiguration may do so via the following methods:

Mass offertory contributions and donations to the church are NOT tax exempt.

1. Electronic Bank Transfer

- i) Select Bank Transfer PayNow option
- ii) Key in COTT Parish **UEN: T15CC0001D**
- iii) Check and ensure recipient's name is – **Church of the Transfiguration**
- iv) Key in your contribution amount
- v) Key in the reference as “**Mass Collection**”

2. In Person (for cash & cheques only)

Please put your offering in an envelope or red packet with the words “**Mass Offertory**”. Then drop it into the donation box outside the main church on Level 2.

3. Mail in a cheque

Make out your cheque to: “**Church of the Transfiguration**”

A. Access & Complete Online Form

(<http://transfiguration.sg/prayerintention>)

Complete the Prayer Intention Form via the link above.

Enter a contactable phone number. Select the name of the person or the specific intention you wish the Mass to be prayed for. Specify the date of the Mass. **This date must be at least 2 weeks AFTER the date of this online submission.** Once all fields have been completed, submit the form. You will receive an email confirmation with an auto-generated number. Please note that there will be no follow up email on the day of the Mass.

B. Bank Online

Use PayNow to transfer the donation for the Mass prayer intention. Ensure the following are keyed in correctly:

1. **UEN** for Church of the Transfiguration is **T15CC0001D**.
2. **Reference Field** to key in: Intention Ref MAXXXXX.

C. Communion with the Church

PARISH INFORMATION

INFANT BAPTISM

Application forms (available at the Parish Office) must be completed and submitted with relevant documents attached. Parents and godparents will be informed of the date and time of the preparatory session that they would need to attend as well as the actual date of baptism.

WEDDING

Kindly register your intention to get married at the Parish Office at least 12 months before your intended date. This is to ensure that you have sufficient time to go for your marriage preparation and your celebrant is able to make the date.

ANOINTING OF THE SICK

Anointing of the Sick can be administered to any Catholic who is awaiting serious surgery, suffers from serious illness or is weakened by old age.

Kindly contact the Parish Office to request for a priest to administer the sacrament. In emergencies, either the priests of the parish or priests of the church nearest to the hospital can be contacted.

PRO BONO MEDIATION

Catholic Lawyers Guild ("CLG") Pro Bono Mediation -

You can resolve your disputes without going to Court. An accredited Mediator can assist disputants to enter into a legally enforceable Settlement Agreement which provides a win-win situation for both sides. The service is free, for eligible applicants.
